Scoutmaster Report - Rich or Gaylene

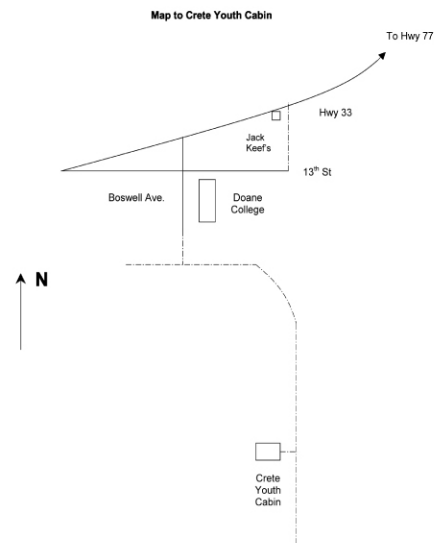
The camporee at Cornhusker with nine boys went well. At about 2 AM we were all awakened by canon fire but no one was injured. <g> Four adults attended. Dave pulled the trailer this weekend to Camp Cornhusker. No work was completed on the Fox campsite as it wasn't necessary. The ranges weren't open in the afternoon; games were played instead. Heaps of fun was had by all, including cooking and exploring the area. Saltdog patches were issued to attendees.

Treasurer's Report - Steve C.

We have \$1,909.71 in savings account, \$2,828.47 in checking account, \$1,3980.76 at the OEC in our Scouting accounts, summer camp fees (\$100 of \$131) need to be made. A motion to repay certain Scouts from their camping funds was passed without dissent. Popcorn sales came in at approximately \$4,000. At \$.25 per box, an additional \$74 was earned; \$ 2,526.65 profit was realized while \$1,474.35 was put into Scouts' accounts, depending on how much each Scout sold. The \$74 was divided also, depending on percent of who sold what. Nathan Hunt sold over \$500 in popcorn - way to go ! This will help pay for several items. This is a 38 percent increase (about \$1,100) in sales over last year. 21 Scouts sold popcorn. The 'show and sell approach' seemed to work well. Greenery sales are due this week.



Outdoor committee report - Kevin

We are planning some exciting outdoor activities for next year. We've made a deposit to Ben Delatour Scout Ranch (BDSR) for summer camp 2006, held from 09 - 15 July 2006. What about Elkhorn high adventure? That's a separate registration through Longs Peak Council. To join Venture Crew, a young person must be at least in 7th grade. There are 29 Scouts we know of who are or will be eligible for next year. The person must also be a First Class Scout - young women can join Ventures if they meet the requirements. Menards has blue tarps on sale now.
