- [ ] Gaylene's WoodBadge ticket includes work on Scout morale. She's also looking at training.

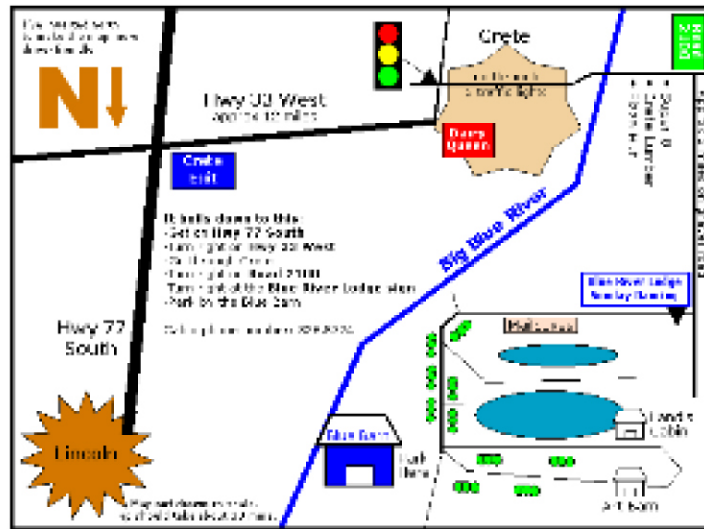
